Third Party Exam Fees

Aviation: \$1,050¹ – General, Airframe, Powerplant (Written, Oral and Practical) – 9 exams

Energy (other than Wind): \$320 – OSHA, NFPA 70 E Arch Flash, EPA 608, AHA First Aid, AHA CPR, AHA AED, Universal R-410A, NIULPE 5th Class

Wind: \$190 – OSHA, NFPA 70 E Arch Flash, EPA 608, AHA First Aid, AHA CPR, AHA AED

HVACR: \$170 – EPA 608, Universal R-410A, NATE Core

¹If a student chooses to take all third party exams at MIAT, all exam fees will be covered (estimated \$1,500). If a student chooses to test at a facility outside of MIAT, the maximum limit of \$1,050, noted above, will apply
