### Third Party Exam Fees

**Aviation: \$1,050<sup>1</sup>** – General, Airframe, Powerplant (Written, Oral and Practical) – 9 exams

**Energy (other than Wind): \$320** – OSHA, NFPA 70 E Arch Flash, EPA 608, AHA First Aid, AHA CPR, AHA AED, Universal R-410A, NIULPE 5<sup>th</sup> Class

**Wind: \$190** – OSHA, NFPA 70 E Arch Flash, EPA 608, AHA First Aid, AHA CPR, AHA AED

**HVACR: \$170** – EPA 608, Universal R-410A, NATE Core
